

## Open Source Subject Database Project (Drupal) <http://cbmm.mit.edu/ossdp>

Uncompress the “ossdp files.zip” file and move files to your servers web hosting folder. This contains the Drupal 10.1.7 files and all associated website files to get your site going.

Import the “mysql database.sql.zip” file into your SQL server. The current username is “admin” and password is “OSSDPpass10!”. For security, these should be changed for your install and new information updated on the “/sites/default/settings.php” to allow your website to connect to your database.

The trusted\_host\_patterns setting is not configured in settings.php. This can lead to security vulnerabilities. It is **highly recommended** that you configure this. See [Protecting against HTTP HOST Header attacks](#) for more information.

In settings.php, it's recommended to change the Hash Salt to keep your one time password generation, token, etc. secure.
